



NOTICE TO TRAINERS

IMPLEMENTATION OF RULES RELATING TO CLENBUTEROL

Attention is drawn to the implementation of the new JCSA Rules of Racing 8.50 relating to clenbuterol-containing preparations.

Participants are reminded that the administration of clenbuterol is prohibited:

- on race day; and
- during the thirty (30) clear days before race day.

Any horse that has been administered clenbuterol is not eligible to race for thirty (30) clear days following the administration.

The Stewards may order the scratching of a horse where:

- a breach of this rule has occurred; or
- the Stewards reasonably suspect that clenbuterol has been administered in breach of the Rules.

Participants are further advised that if a horse races following a breach of this rule, the horse may be disqualified from the relevant race.

Example – 30 Clear Day Stand-Down Period

If a horse receives treatment on 1 January, the day of treatment is not counted.

The thirty (30) clear day stand-down period begins on 2 January. The thirtieth clear day falls on **31 January**. Accordingly, provided all other requirements of the JCSA Rules of Racing have been met, the horse **is eligible to race from 1 February**
